- * Please let us know well in advance if you need high chairs and cots. These may be available depending on the number of requests.
Alternatively you're welcome to bring your own.

Arrival

Arrival time is 2pm. Early entry can be arranged prior with management.

To get to Lake Ainsworth by road from the south

- * Follow the Pacific Highway through to Ballina
- * Follow the signs through Ballina to Lennox Head
- * Continue through the Lennox Head township on Pacific Parade past the surf club
- * The Centre is on Pacific Parade on the northern end of Lake Ainsworth.

To get to Lake Ainsworth by road from the north

- * Follow the Pacific Highway through to the Lennox Head turn off Ross Lane, south of Knockrow
- * Turn right at the first T intersection
- * Turn left into the Lennox Head township
- * Turn left again at the T intersection at the ocean and follow Pacific Parade north past the surf club to the northern end of Lake Ainsworth.

Departure

Departure time is 10am unless prior arrangements are made with management. Before leaving, we would value your help by:

- * Placing one doona and pillow on each bed
- * Washing any used dishes
- * Placing rubbish from your room, around your unit and used barbecue area in the green bins outside
- * Return furniture and utensils to correct unit
- * Closing all windows and doors
- * Return key to office through key return slot if office is unattended.

Note: All cleaning products are to be provided by the client.



Facilities

Guests are welcome to use the swimming pool, tennis courts, basketball courts, the oval playing area and bush walking tracks around the Centre. Clients are requested not to enter the Lodge area at the Southern end of the Centre.

Tennis/Basketball courts

There are two artificial grass courts, contact the office for availability and if you require the court lights on. Hours of play are 7.30am to 9pm. Tennis racquets, balls and basketballs are not available for hire. Two hard courts are located near the tennis courts.

Swimming pool

Use of the pool is during daylight hours only. All children are to be accompanied by an adult.

Also please adhere to the following rules:

- * Keep gates locked at all times
- * No glass bottles inside the pool
- * No alcohol inside the pool
- * No food inside the pool area

Keys to access the pool are attached to the cottage keys.

Other facilities

Other facilities can be used if you have booked an instructor for your group. We ask that you do not enter Centre buildings unless touring with Centre staff. Please keep children away from the maintenance/workshop area.

Barbeques

Barbeques are available for all our self-contained cottages. Lights are located in the laundry block in the eastern toilet. After use, please turn off the gas bottles. After evening barbeques, please turn off the lights.

Car parking

Car parking is available for each cottage in the the car park at the western side of the cottage.

Laundry

Our guest laundry is located at the rear of Cottages 1-4 see Attachment 2 . Washing machines and dryers are available please bring your own laundry powder and pegs. There are also additional toilets located in the laundry.

Respecting others

A number of different groups may be using the self contained cottages at once. Similarly, it's likely that the lodge area of the Centre will be booked by a community-based group. Consider those nearby and remember that facilities are to be shared by guests.

Alcohol and smoking

The consumption of alcohol in moderation is permitted in certain areas of the Centre and these areas will be pointed out during your orientation session. Alcohol must not be consumed in the lodges. The Centre Manager reserves the right to ban alcohol or evict guests whose alcohol use is causing intoxication or disturbing other guests.

There are designated smoking areas at the Centre.

Please dispose of cigarette butts considerately.

Security

Management is available 24 hours a day for emergency situations. The Centre is not responsible for personal items.

Pets

No pets are permitted.

Linen

You will need to provide bed linen, pillowcases and towels. A doona and pillow are provided on each bed.

Rubbish

Bins can be emptied into the bin closest to your unit. Centre staff remove rubbish regularly.

Staff assistance

Lake Ainsworth staff are on call at all times to assist you during your stay. In case of an emergency press the button, located on the western side of the administration building to contact on call staff or call 000.

Accommodation

Cottages

The cottages are located north of the main section of the Centre separated from the main buildings by the swimming pool, tennis courts and playing fields.

The area around the cottages provides an ideal playing area for the children without the worry of traffic.

The pool is available for your use, along with the tennis courts though tenants need to bring their own raquets and balls.

Cottages 1 to 4 have two bedrooms, one has two single beds, the other has two double bunks, ensuite, kitchen, dining/lounge room, TV, laundry, deck area and communal BBQ area.

Cottages 5 to 9 have two bedrooms, one has one single bed and a double bed, the other has one single and a double bunk, three-way bathroom, kitchen, dining/lounge room, laundry, TV and deck area.

Beach Side Lodge

The lodge is fully self contained and has five rooms, one room has three single beds and two bunk beds, three rooms have three single beds, a duo bed (a double bed with a single above) and a bunk bed and the other room has two single beds, ensuites in all rooms, kitchen/dining, TV, lounge area, laundry and verandah.

Note All self-contained accommodation requires you to bring your own linen, towels, food, cleaning and personal items.

Bookings are for a minimum of two nights with weekly bookings from Saturday 2pm until the following Saturday 10am during selected school holidays. Weekend bookings are available from Friday afternoon until Sunday morning.
